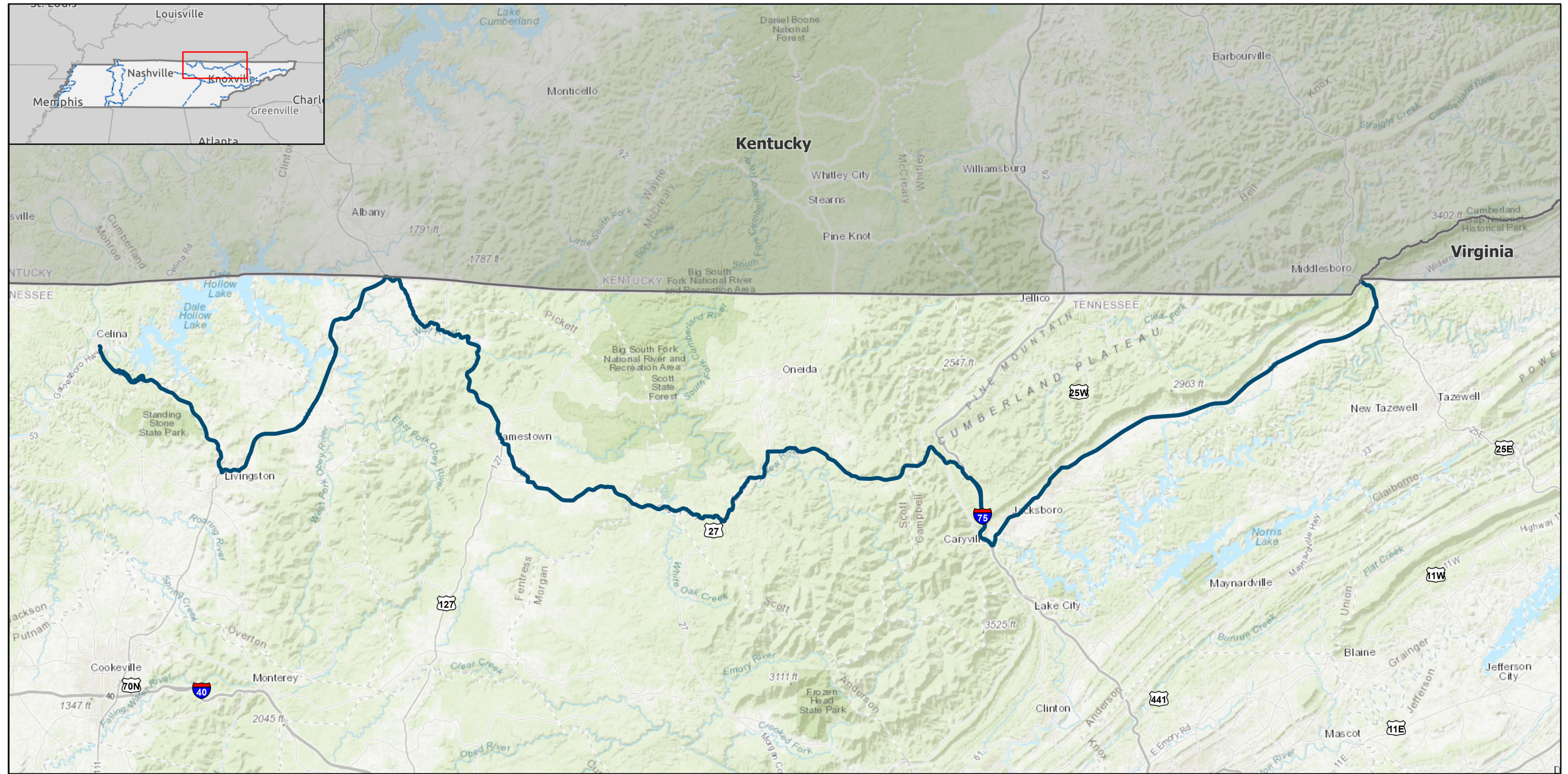

Begin by in Harrogate, Tennessee on TN-63. Scenic Byway begins near Lincoln Memorial University, at the intesection of TN-63 and US-25 E. Travel west for 38 miles to Caryville, Tennessee. Pass through the towns of Powell Valley, Speedwell, LaFollette and Jacksboro, Tennessee on TN-63. Turn right to merge onto I-75 north at mile marker 134 and proceed for 7 miles. Exit I-75 at mile marker 141 and proceed east on TN-63 and TN-297 for 20 miles to Helenwood, Tennessee. Turn left onto US-27 and proceed south for 8 miles to Elgin, Tennessee. Turn right onto S.R. 52 and proceed west for 23 miles, passing through Historic Rugby and the Big South Fork National Recreation Area. In Jamestown, Tennessee turn right onto U.S. 127 north and continue for 21 miles. Pass through Pall Mall, Tennessee and turn left onto TN-111. Proceed southwest for 23 miles through Livingston, Tennessee. In Livingston, turn right onto TN-52 W for 16 miles to the Celina, Tennessee. End at the Livingston, Tennessee limits near the Cumberland River.
