


The Great River Road

Tennessee Scenic Byway

From Louisville, Kentucky: Travel south from Louisville, Kentucky to Natchez Trace Parkway, Tennessee. Head south on I-65 toward Nashville, Tennessee. Take the Memphis/Huntsville exit onto I-65 south. Take Exit 84B/Memphis onto I-40 west. Take Exit 199/Old Hickory Boulevard (TN-251). Turn south onto Old Hickory Boulevard (TN-251). Turn west onto TN-100. Take ramp onto Natchez Trace Parkway. From Memphis, Tennessee to Natchez Trace Parkway, Mississippi: From Memphis, Tennessee, head east on I-40 toward Nashville. In Memphis, take Exit 1E/Jackson, Mississippi onto I-240 south. Take Exit 2A/Shelby Drive/Capleville onto East Shelby Drive (TN-175). Bear southeast onto Lamar Avenue (US-78). Continue to follow US-78 toward Tupelo, Mississippi.

From Nashville, TN to Natchez Trace Parkway: Take TN-1 southwest to Belle Meade. Get on TN-100 and continue southwest to the byway in Pasquo.
